

## Updates and Options regarding the ‘Math Interventionist Certificate’

1. Some conference attendees who did not attend the November Workshop may wish to obtain the ‘Math Interventionist Certificate’ from Adams State College (more information can be found at [www.cocld.org](http://www.cocld.org)). These participants may take an additional one hour, on-line credit course from Adams State as a substitute course.
2. Recommended *one credit-hour* course substitutions from Adams State include:
  - a. Math 221: ‘Count on It’ Number Sense
  - b. Math 511: ‘Just the Stats: Data Analysis
  - c. ED 589: ‘Teaching Elementary and Middle Level Math’
  - d. ED 589: ‘Math: Classifying, Ordering, and Exploring Read, Negative, and Whole Numbers’
3. Conference participants wishing to access this option must work directly with Adams State College to enroll in and complete the selected class.
4. Finally, as noted on the [www.cocld.org](http://www.cocld.org) website, participants wishing to earn the ‘Math Interventionist Certificate’ must also enroll in and successfully complete the week-long ‘Math Boot Camp’ training offered in July of 2010.
